



Rainbow Station to open in Raleigh, NC

(Richmond, VA. January 9, 2008) Rainbow Station, an early childhood education provider, will open in Raleigh, NC in 2009. The franchise is owned by David and Joy Abel.

Rainbow Station offers unique programs for children as young as infants up through age 14, including a preschool program, which has a proprietary curriculum based on Standards of Learning, nursery school, private kindergarten, and a school-age recreation program called The Village.
