Rainbow Station education programs coming to Charlotte

Rainbow Station, a provider of early childhood education programs, will be located on Providence Rd. West at Community House Road. It will open in August 2008, just in time for the new school year. Rainbow Station, which is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children, offers preschool, nursery school, private kindergarten and The Village, an after-school recreation and summer camp program. The Get Well Place at Rainbow Station provides an onsite facility to care for children who are mildly ill when their parents must work, and is staffed by a full-time registered pediatric nurse.
